About the Call

The window to submit proposals is now closed. Notifications will be distributed in mid-October to the primary contact.

Four invited session program types:

- Postgraduate
 - 3-hour timeslot, and can be collaborated on with affiliate organizations
 - CME and Maintenance of Certification (MOC) credits available
 - Included in the registration fee for members; at-cost for non-members
- Breakfast
 - 90-minute timeslot scheduled on Friday and Saturday mornings
 - Can be collaborated on with affiliate organizations
 - CME and Maintenance of Certification (MOC) credits available
 - Included in the registration fee, but ticketed for food & beverage purposes
- Concurrent
 - 90-minute timeslot scheduled throughout meeting
 - Can be collaborated on with affiliate organizations, with CME credit available
- Small group
 - 60-minute timeslot scheduled throughout meeting
 - 1-2 subject matter experts open the session for case studies in an intimate setting
