MISSION

The SVS Foundation's mission is: To optimize the vascular health and well-being of patients and the public through support of research that leads to discovery of knowledge and innovative strategies, as well as education and programs, to prevent and treat circulatory disease. The SVS Foundation is committed to funding the future of vascular health through research and innovation, patient education, disease prevention and diversity, equity and inclusion.

POSITION

The Board will support the work of the SVS Foundation and provide mission-based leadership and support. While the day-to-day operations are led by the Foundation's executive director, the relationship between staff and the Board is a partnership and the appropriate involvement of the Board is critical. Specific Board member responsibilities include:

Leadership, governance and oversight

- Serve on Foundation workgroups as needed
- Act as the Foundation's enthusiastic ambassador to help secure philanthropic and corporate sponsorship

Fundraising roles & responsibilities

- Embrace the effort to create a culture of philanthropy: a commitment to a donor-centered perspective, focused on strategic relationship building resulting in steadily increased philanthropic and corporate sponsorship revenues
- Assist in developing and implementing strategies to increase the number of SVS members that contribute to the SVS Annual Fund
- Make a personal financial commitment to the SVS Foundation's Annual Fund at the major donor gift level
- Strive to secure Annual Fund major gift commitments from the Foundation member's other related vascular medical organizations, as well as his/her medical center, department, business, grateful patients, and/or corporations
- Help to identify, rate and develop strategies for securing major gift commitments from key individuals, family foundations, institutional foundations, grateful patients, medical partnerships, and other likely corporate/business prospects
- Assist in "opening doors," cultivating and/or soliciting a limited number of additional key major gift prospects (individuals, foundations and corporate representatives)
- Work diligently to assure the success of the Foundation's special projects, including the Vascular Surgery Annual Gala, STEP Challenge and other special events

The position is a rewarding opportunity for an individual who is passionate about the Foundation's mission and who has a track record of volunteer leadership.
