Program Overview

In early 2025, the Society for Vascular Surgery (SVS), the Society for Vascular Nursing (SVN), and the American Podiatric Medical Association (APMA) will jointly release an innovative, interprofessional Wound Care Curriculum. The curriculum is designed to provide participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to address chronic wound management, including the latest treatment guidelines, diagnostic tools, and advanced therapeutic options.

This comprehensive educational initiative addresses the critical need for specialized, multidisciplinary education in wound care and limb salvage, focusing specifically on vascular surgeons, advanced practice providers, physician assistants (PAs), and podiatrists. We anticipate over 200 providers will participate in our on-demand course with an estimated 75 attending the hands-on workshop at the VAM25.

Curriculum Highlights

The Wound Care Curriculum will consist of:

- An on-demand course with 27 videos on the fundamentals of wound care released via SVS VascuLEARN in February 2025
- The on-demand course is a part of a blended learning format combining online content with hands-on Masterclass Workshops held at VAM 2025, 2026 and 2027.
 - Each workshop will focus on hands-on learning and advanced techniques, putting into practice the content from the on-demand course.
- CME, CEUs, and CE credits will be available for medical professionals in vascular surgery, nursing, podiatric medicine, and wound care specialties
- Learners will participate in pre-and post testing to assess their understanding of the content and their ability to apply new skills into practice.
