Medical Writer

The medical writer position is a part-time role that will write and edit medical and scientific documents, including research-related documents, disease or therapy-related literature, and manuscripts for journals. Analyze and interpret data for manuscripts as needed. This position will oversee the overall management of writing activities as assigned, ensuring a consistent methodology and alignment with the projects. The medical editor will work collaboratively with the Director on emerging areas and joint writing initiatives, as needed, in support of the goals of the organization.

What you'll own

- Take primary lead in developing papers.
- Provide overall staff for writing papers assigned.
- Work with the Director of Quality Practice to collaborate with other QP initiatives as needed.
- Assist in writing practice guidelines and guidance for derivative products such as point-of-care tools.
- Promote expanded dissemination and implementation of guidelines, including through website updates, news articles, and other distribution channels.
- Maintain regular communication with the Director.
- Other projects/activities and duties may be assigned at times.

What you'll bring to the job

- Advanced degree is required (MPH, PhD, MD or master's in health sciences, epidemiology, healthcare administration or clinical areas).
- A minimum of 3 years' experience in writing scientific/medical papers, or writing for medical societies, associations or healthcare organizations. Analyses of aggregate data is a plus.
- Conducting literature reviews and summarizing data. Some understanding of medical terminology, clinical research, and data interpretation will be required to develop papers.
- Project and people management skills, including demonstrated ability to coordinate and complete multiple large projects simultaneously with minimal supervision, work with external consultants, and still meet strict deadlines for projects at various stages over several years.
- Highly motivated, result-oriented, and able to prioritize efforts to use limited resources efficiently.
- Demonstrated skills to apply effective oral, electronic, and written communication methods with colleagues and volunteers.
- Ability to work effectively with all multi-disciplinary team members, both internal and external.
- Flexibility and adaptability and the ability to work independently and meet deadlines.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office, specifically in Outlook, Word, PowerPoint, Excel, and OneNote, is required.
